Enjoy a tasty lunch created for us by a local Whidbey Island chef!

Before “tested compatible glass” there was enameled window glass. You can participate in the renaissance of glass enamels as we explore and fuse vitreous enamels and metals with inexpensive window glass. Presented through an historical context, participants will fuse enamels on top, in between, and underneath the glass surface, creating vessels and tiles. We will make a beach-sand slumping mold, paint low fire enamels onto vessels, and using aluminum, brass, copper, and silver -- fuse metals and glass. Hopefully recycled glass and vitreous enamels can move us toward an inexpensive, environmentally friendlier, “green glass” revolution. **The workshop is \$295 including materials.**
