

Whidbey Island Master Class

a Special Five Day Advanced Glass Workshop

with Richard La Londe at his Studio

October 8 - 12th

This class is limited to 6 Participants and you must be proficient in glass cutting, glass fusing, and also have attended one of my workshops, where you learned the "liquid glass line" technique.

Make larger fused glass pieces and take your art to a professional level!
Participants in this Master Class will design and make a 20" x 20" wall piece with an aluminum backing plate - ready to hang on your wall. You will also fabricate a "La Londe-style" wavy stainless steel mold. We will work in the hot shop of Island Glass Studio with Rob Adamson where you will decorate and hand-roll sheet glass - one of these sheets will then be slumped into your metal mold. We will photograph our glass pieces and then pack our glass art and metal mold to ship home. Professional practices including galleries, public art, photography, safely shipping glass will be discussed.

Richard La Londe's studio is located on beautiful Whidbey Island about 1_ hours including the short ferry ride, from downtown Seattle, Washington. A Motel or Bed & Breakfasts are available on the Island. This is an opportunity to study and interact with a pioneer in glass fusing and author of **Richard La Londe: Fused Glass Art and Technique**, and **Richard La Londe & Friends - Book II**, in his own studio.

Materials fee \$200 (includes 3 lunches at the studio)

Hot Shop fee \$100
